## COVID 19

### REHEARSAL/PERFORMANCE PROTOCOLS

**The Cherry Creek Chorale will continue to require vaccinations for members and staff of the Chorale. Singing is considered a high-risk activity and many of our members are in high-risk groups. We cannot eliminate the risk of transmission in our group, but we will continue to take steps to help minimize the impact of COVID on the health of our members.**

1. All performers and staff participating with the CCC must show proof of a completed vaccination regimen.
2. Boosters are not required, but strongly encouraged and recommended.
3. Masks will be optional at rehearsals and performances.
4. Masks will be optional but recommended for all audience members and volunteers at concerts.
5. During rehearsal breaks, if possible, leave the rehearsal room and disperse into other areas around Bethany as much as possible. This is recommended by the ACDA guidelines.
6. If a member is sick or feeling unwell for any reason – COVID OR NOT — they should NOT attend rehearsal.
  - a. The Chorale is providing online practice tools for you to rehearse and practice music at home, to make up for any missed rehearsal.
  - b. For health related absences, there will be some flexibility in the attendance policy. This will need to be approved by your section leader and/or Brian Leatherman.

7. If a member learns they are positive for COVID they should notify their section leader. The section leader will notify Brian L. and the Board President. The Board will inform the choir of the possible exposure.
  - a. We will reveal as much information as the member permits, but a minimum will be the rehearsal impacted and the member's section.
  - b. Based on this information, individual members should take whatever personal action they believe is appropriate —  
— testing, quarantine, etc.
8. If you have direct exposure to someone with COVID do not come to rehearsal or performance until you have been symptom free for five days or have a negative COVID test.

The CCC Board and Staff monitor changes in the ongoing COVID environment and will update and make changes to the protocols as necessary. We will notify the Chorale members and post updates here.
